2 WHAT ARE COOKIES?

Cookies are small files that can be used to improve your user experience on our website. The cookies are stored on your computer or mobile device when you visit our site.

There are two main types of cookies, session cookies and permanent cookies. Session cookies are temporary cookies and are deleted after your visit to our website when you close the browser. Permanent cookies are stored for a longer time depending on their purpose, typically for 2 years.

Depending on your preferences, we use cookies and similar technologies on this website to improve user experience and to improve our service by analysing traffic on our website and the functioning of our features, and for marketing purposes.

Some cookies are so-called third-party cookies and are placed on our site by third parties.

3 WHAT KIND OF COOKIES DO WE USE?

Necessary cookies

Necessary cookies implement functions that are necessary for the functioning and proper use of the website. For example, these cookies enable the proper

navigation on the website by saving your login information while you browse from one page to another on our website. These cookies cannot be turned off.

Preference cookies

Preference cookies enable us to personalise the website according to your preferences. For example, they are used to save information about past choices you made on the website, such as your language settings.

Statistics cookies

Statistics cookies help us to understand how our visitors use the website. These cookies help us compile statistics on how visitors move around the website and which pages on our website are popular. We use this information to improve our website.

Marketing cookies

Marketing cookies make it possible to display relevant ads on a website. These cookies track your behaviour across different websites. Some of the marketing cookies are used and put on our website by third parties, Google, You Tube, Facebook and LinkedIn. 4 WHEN DO WE USE COOKIES?

Necessary cookies are required for the proper functioning of the website. These are mandatory and cannot be turned off. We use all other cookies only based on your consent. You can accept the use of all cookies or only specific categories of cookies in the cookie settings using the cookie settings banner on the page. You can also withdraw your consent for the use of the cookies at any time using the same.

5 RIGHTS OF THE DATA SUBJECT

As a data subject, you have certain rights under the General Data Protection Regulation 2016/679 (GDPR). Below are short descriptions of these rights.

Right to access: Data subjects have the right to receive confirmation from the controller on whether the controller is processing personal data that

concerns them. The controller must provide the data subject with a copy of the personal data being processed. As a rule, the exercise of rights is free of charge.

Right to rectification: Data subjects have the right to demand the rectification of inaccurate personal data concerning them and to have incomplete personal data completed.

Right to erasure: In certain cases, specified in Article 17 of the GDPR, the data subject has the right to have the controller erase data concerning them. For example, when the personal data is no longer necessary in relation to the purposes for which it was collected or otherwise processed.

Right to restriction of processing: In certain cases, specified in Article 18 of the GDPR, the data subject can request the controller to restrict the processing of personal data concerning them. The right to restriction exists, for example, when the data subject contests the accuracy of the personal data. In such cases, the processing will be restricted for a period enabling the controller to verify the accuracy of the personal data.

Right to object: In certain situations, the data subject has the right to object to the processing of their personal data, that is, request the controller not to process it at all. If the data is processed for the performance of a task carried out for the purposes of the compelling legitimate interests pursued by the controller or a third party, the data subject has the right to object to the processing on grounds relating to their particular situation. In such cases, the processing must be stopped unless the controller demonstrates compelling legitimate grounds for the processing which override the interests, rights, and freedoms of the data subject.

If the personal data is processed for direct marketing based on legitimate interest, the data subject has the right to object at any time to the processing without any specific grounds, after which the data may no longer be processed for purposes of direct marketing (this includes profiling related to direct marketing).

Right to data portability: The data subject has the right to receive the personal data that they have provided to a controller in a structured, commonly used, and machine-readable format and, if desired, transmit that data to another controller.

Right to withdraw consent: If personal data is processed based on consent, the data subject has the right to withdraw consent by informing the controller. Withdrawal of consent does not affect the lawfulness of the processing carried out prior to the withdrawal of consent.

Right to lodge a complaint with the supervisory authority: The data subject has the right to lodge a complaint with the competent supervisory

authority if the data subject considers that the controller has not complied with the applicable data protection regulation.
